



WHY A SNOW RUN?

There are many worthwhile organizations raising money in the name of cancer research: The Kelly Shires Foundation is different. Formed out of a passion for snowmobiling and an equal passion for helping breast cancer patients, the Foundation distributes funds directly to those battling breast cancer across Canada.

Through personal experience, Kelly realized that dealing with the physical, emotional and financial aspects of this disease can be very tough. The charity actively helps patients year-round however, the primary fund raising event is a "women only snowmobile event" held annually in early February.

WOMEN HELPING WOMEN

At the age of 34, Kelly Shires' life was changed forever (Christmas 1997). Kelly and her husband Ken were running a successful dry land marine facility and expecting their first child when Kelly discovered a lump in her breast. It was a difficult and emotional time of their life; within a week, Kelly had four surgeries, terminated the pregnancy and began six months of chemotherapy. Due to the financial strain of battling the illness, they gave up their business and moved to the Georgian Bay area to begin a quieter lifestyle and concentrate on Kelly's recovery. Through her own personal struggles, Kelly realized that she wanted to help others who had Breast Cancer. Together with her friend, Suzy Stenoff, this tragedy was turned into something positive creating the Kelly Shires Breast Cancer Snow Run. On October 31, 2004 Kelly lost her battle with breast cancer, but her spirit and determination live on thanks in part to a dedicated group of volunteers. Please join us in our journey to keep Kelly's dream alive.

HOW IS MONEY DISTRIBUTED?

Patients submit a completed application, along with medical and financial information. Once an application for assistance is received, a committee reviews the application and determines if the applicant meets the Foundation's requirements. All applications are handled in the strictest of confidence. Funds are disbursed as soon as the application is approved, Typically within 7 - 14 days.
